Sunday was the start of concurrent sessions. There were so many great options that choosing was difficult, but you couldn't go wrong!

If you had seen a quilt on display outside of the Ballroom for the past couple of days, the reason became clear during the Code Orange plenary session. A Code Orange, for anyone unfamiliar with the term, aims to coordinate a safe and effective response to an external disaster or event that may increase the capacity of the hospital. In the case of the presentation discussed yesterday, it referred to the horrific bus crash that occurred April 6, 2018, taking the lives of several members of the Humboldt, SK hockey team and injuring many others. Our thanks go to Alma and Anne-Marie from Royal University Hospital in Saskatoon for sharing the trials and triumphs of the unbelievable tragedy, including the PTSD experienced by the hospital staff, challenges faced, and lessons learned. *When was the last time that your site reviewed its Code Orange protocol? It's time!*

After the crash, a project was launched to make 29 quilts, one to represent each person lost from the crash. That number quickly grew, and before long, hundreds of quilts had been stitched, personifying the love and support for the town of Humboldt. One of these quilts

was donated to ORNAC for a draw held at the end of the presentation. **It was won by Angela Wylie of Ottawa amid many tears.**
