

Eligibility Criteria: ORNAC Board and Executive positions

Eligibility Criteria Directors:

Each Director shall be (ORNAC bylaw 5.03):

- An individual who is not less than eighteen (18) years of age.
- A Member of the Association in good standing.
- Employed as a Canadian Perioperative Registered Nurse.
- Mentally competent. That is he/she has not been found by a court in Canada or elsewhere to be mentally incompetent.
- Financially stable having not been bankrupt.

Each Officer, *in addition to the above*, shall be:

- A current director on the ORNAC board OR
- A director who has served a full term within the past 2 years-Bylaw 6.03
- In attendance for at least 70% of ORNAC Board meetings while in a director position

Leadership Criteria: Preference will be given to members of CORL. (Canadian Operating Room Leaders)

Eligibility Criteria:

- Baccalaureate degree preferred.
- Current CPN(C) designation preferred.
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience in a Perioperative Leadership Role.
- Willingness to work on ORNAC Committees.
- Ability to attend ORNAC meetings and to volunteer on committees and at National Conferences.

Advanced Practice Criteria: Preference will be given to Members of RNFANC. (Registered Nurse First Assistant Network of Canada.)

Eligibility Criteria:

- Baccalaureate degree preferred;
- Current CPN(C) designation preferred;
- Graduate of a recognized RNFA program;
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience as an RNFA;
- Willingness to work on ORNAC Committees; and
- Ability to attend ORNAC meetings and to volunteer on committees and at National Conferences.

Education Criteria: Preference will be given to members of PNEC.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Baccalaureate degree preferred;
- Current CPN(C) designation preferred;
- Minimum of 5 years perioperative education experience (academic setting or clinical environment);
- Proven ability to apply adult learning principles and electronic learning strategies;
- Experience with program development and delivery, synchronous and asynchronous learning, and electronic learning and facilitation preferred.
- Experience writing learning outcomes, goals, and creation of and application of assessment and evaluation preferred;
- Experience with delivery of oral presentations and with development of poster presentations preferred;
- Willingness to work on ORNAC Committees; and
- Ability to attend ORNAC meetings and to volunteer on committees and at National Conferences.
